DRESS CODE

TINY TOES & PETITE CLASSES

*For this age group we do not enforce a dress code. Dancers/parents can pick any color & style of outfit that is appropriate for physical activity. Ballet shoes are also optional at this age, as some Tiny Toes & Petite dancers have trouble with the new feeling of dance shoes... while others are very excited about it! Basically, anything goes as long as it is not distracting to the dancers during their lesson. Our main goal for this age group is that they feel comfortable and happy for class ©

*IF purchasing ballet or tap shoes, please do not do so from Target. The quality is not appropriate for dance classes. Any other dance attire from Target is ok!

Below are our recommendations...

<u>GIRLS:</u> A conservative one-piece tutu dress is preferred, as separate leotards with skirts can become distracting for this age group. Any t-shirt with dance shorts/leggings is also acceptable. Pink ballet tights with pink ballet shoes or no tights with bare feet. Hair pulled back and off of the face is recommended.

<u>BOYS:</u> Any color t-shirt, with any color shorts, leggings or sweatpants. Black ballet shoes or bare feet.

GIRLS TAP SHOES ONLY FOR CLASSES CONSISTING OF TAP: CAPEZIO CHILD "JR. TYETTE" RIBBON TIE TAP SHOES IN PATENT BLACK ARE REQUIRED FOR ANY COMBO CLASSES CONSISTING OF TAP.

BOYS TAP SHOES ONLY FOR CLASSES CONSISTING OF TAP: BLACK LACE UP TAP SHOES ARE REQUIRED FOR ANY COMBO CLASSES CONSISTING OF TAP.

FOR ALL CLASSES

*Girls hair should be pulled or clipped away from face when possible

Please do not wear loose or dangling jewelry and accessories to class for your own safety and the safety of other dancers. We recommend leaving it at home, to avoid the disappointment of taking it off and then losing something precious at the studio.

FOR COLDER MONTHS - WARM UP GEAR

Snug fitting ballet wrap sweaters, cardigans, cap-sleeved or long-sleeved leotards are all great options to stay warm during the colder months. Ankle or leg warmers are encouraged. No bulky or loose clothing please. Hoodies & winter jackets are not appropriate warm-up gear for dance class. They are often too bulky & distracting for the dancers.
